

Notes for organisers

By adding your names to this petition letter, you will join parishes across England, Wales and Scotland in showing a strong and faithful Catholic commitment to caring for creation and our neighbours.

Step 1: Encourage as many people as possible in your parish to sign the petition letter below to Prime Minister David Cameron.

You could do so after Mass, at an event or by going to different groups within the parish. Use the text above in the announcements and your newsletter, with any details of when and how you'll be collecting signatures.

Make sure you add your details in the organiser's section of the petition letter.

Step 2: Send your parish's signed petition letter to Campaigns team, CAFOD, Romero House, 55 Westminster Bridge Road, London, SE1 7JB

We will send you a thank-you poster and will add your names to the hundreds of thousands of others which will be presented to world leaders before December's climate summit in Paris.

Take a **copy** of your signed petition and give or send it to your local MP to show your commitment to action and to ask them what they are doing to tackle climate change.
