This year, the Easter Scene Painting Competition is again extended to 4 year groups in Schools and Parishes in East Anglia with Provincial prizes for the winners of all four groups at both Primary and Secondary stage,

KS 1 - School Year Groups: Reception, 1 and 2, (5 to 7 years of age),

KS 2 - School Year Groups: 3, 4, 5, and 6, (8 to 11 years of age),

KS 3 - School Year Groups: 7, 8 and 9, (12 to 14 years of age),

KS 4 + School Year Groups: 10, 11, 12 and 13, (15 to 18 years of age).

As in 2017, winning entries of groups KS 3 and KS 4 go forward to the National Final for judging. Please note the overall National winner will be the better winning entry of groups KS 3 and KS 4 combined.

Please note, the school year grouping classification will be the prime age factor.

Entries should depict a biblical scene of the entrant's choice of an incident recalled during the-period from the start of the Easter Triduum, (Feast of the Lord's Supper), to the Feast of Pentecost. Remember, in addition to the important and popular scenes of the Last Supper, those recalling Christ's Passion on the first Good Friday and the Resurrection, there are the Journey to Emmaus, Appearances in the Upper Room and on the Shore of the Sea of Galilee, the Ascension, and Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. Each tell a significant story for artists' talents!

Entries may be sized A4 or A3, on paper of quality and colour of the entrant's choice. Schools and Parishes are asked, where possible, to make a preliminary selection of entries and choose no more than six to go forward to the competition. All entries will be returned in due course. The following detail should be shown legibly in full on the reverse of each entry: Name of entrant, Age of entrant, School Year Group. Name and full address of School/ Parish /Group attended, (eg Liturgy, Brownie or Cub Group etc). Signed by leader.

Entries should be sent by post addressed to Bro. Christopher J. It would be helpful if you contact Bro. Brooks in the first instance if you plan to participate.

The awards after Provincial judging will be: Framed copies of the two winning entries in each group, Certificates signed by the Provincial Great Knight and Cash Prizes of £10.00 and £5.00.

The awards after National judging will be: Overall Winner: Engraved Trophy (Held by the school, group or individual for approximately one year), Certificates signed by the Supreme Knight, Cash Prizes of £75.00, £50.00 and £25.00 respectively for each of the winners in KS3 & KS4 groups. Final results will be announced in early Summer of 2018 and awards will be presented by arrangement with the winning school or parish and all entries returned.
