Our Lady of Lourdes community has, for the past ten months, been in partnership with the hope into action charity, to support three vulnerable men living in Sawston. Nine members of our church community initially put themselves forward as 'Befrienders' to support the residents of the Sawston house who had previously been homeless. Rebekah, the Hope into Action coordinator, manages the project and addresses the specific needs of the residents. The project is ongoing and there have been encouraging achievements but there is now a need to refresh and replenish the 'Befriender' group.

Befrienders need to be able to commit about one hour each week; be good listeners and able to offer supportive and positive comments and action,. In other words live out their religious beliefs with courage and commitment. The 'Befriender' group meets monthly with a great deal of joy and hope aided by a glass of wine!
