\* **From Fr. Pat Cleary:** I am sad to say that after 8 very happy years in St. Laurence's parish, I will be moving to a much smaller parish this Summer. My last day here will be the feast of the Assumption, August 15th. It was with much sadness that I asked Bishop Alan for a smaller parish but in the last two years or so, I have felt unable to respond adequately to all the many, albeit individually justified, calls on my time and energy as a parish priest. As you may know I have been to A&E 4 times in the last 18 months and I think I would be unwise to continue as if nothing had happened. I would ask you please to give the new Parish Priest the same support you have given me and I will announce the parish to which I am going, and the name of the new Parish Priest of St. Laurence once these have been confirmed.

\* **Calais Refugees:** A group of local people collect and transport supplies to the refugees living in the Calais area. They report a desperate shortage of tents and sleeping bags. Just leave them in the Church Hall or Church House after Mass and they will be passed on to the local refugee support group.
