+ **Olive Wood Carves:** We are the Good Shepherd Company from Bethlehem which is based in Nottingham and works alongside with St. Vincent De Paul society for orphans and elderly in the Holy Land. Our goal is to support and help the Christian families in the Holy Land to stay at work as olive wood carves is one of the most important source of income for them, about 90% of the Christians rely on this handicraft. So by selling their produce here from the olive wood (rosaries, crosses, cribs and religious statues) on their behalf, it will prevent the Christians from leaving the country in search of better work opportunities.
