He had been suffering from a sequence of infections over recent weeks, and he died as an inpatient at the West Suffolk Hospital in Ipswich. He was 83 years of age and had been a resident at Montana Care Home since September 2020.

Fr Dick was one of the founding fathers of the Cambourne Catholic Community and a huge advocate for it growing into what we have today.
